New Business

Scholarship Program: On September 10th, I spoke with Carly Layton, the MCCC Foundation Scholarship Coordinator, and determined that Takai Lane is NOT a registered student. As a result, our scholarship funds ARE being applied to the 2025 Scholarship Program.

The club also discussed the Brookdale scholarship program and unanimously voted to fund a \$1000. scholarship to Brookdale for the 2025 scholarship program.

Doug will set up the key 2025 dates for both the Brookdale and MCCC scholarship programs this month.

Winter Hiatus: Jimmy made a motion to skip the winter membership meetings, December, January, and February. The club unanimously accepted the motion. Historically, the December meeting has been the Club's pizza meeting. Bob volunteered to bring pizzas to our November meeting to carry-on the tradition.
